19-year-old Navy sailor from N.J. killed in Virginia crash

A 19-year-old New Jersey man serving in the United States Navy was killed in a single-vehicle cash Friday night in Virginia.

David A. Suescun, of Hackensack, was driving an Acura west on Route 218 in King George County when he lost control of the vehicle, went off the road and struck a tree, Virginia State Police said in a news release.

Suescun was pronounced dead at the scene. A front-seat passenger was hospitalized with serious injuries, according to Sgt. Keeli L. Hill.

Speed was a factor in the crash, which took place just before 8 p.m. near the intersection of Eagles Nest Road, police said.

Suescun made the rank of Fire Controlman in March and was stationed at the Naval Surface Warfare Center in Dahlgren, Virginia, a Navy spokeswoman said.

He enlisted in the Navy in January and went through recruit training in Great Lakes, Illinois.
