MEDICINE, WAS ORDED INTO THE US NAVY

AS A 1ST LT. AND KILLED IN QUANG BIN PROVINCE,
SOUTH VIETNAM

JAN 31, 1968 - AGE 30. HE'S LISTED ON THE
VIETNAM WAR MEMORIAL ON PANEL 36E LINE 22

His address at time of death was
PHILADELPHIA, PA. WHILE IN HHS, STANLEY
PLAYED SOCCER AND BASEBALL. AT THE TIME,
HE RESIDED AT 247 HAMILTON PL, HACKENSACK,
NJ.
